

Your new Rainbow Eucalyptus

Now that you have your very own Rainbow, what you need to know is how to grow it from the size it is now to something like what you see in the picture to the right!

Sunshine

These trees do quite well in full sun, and prefer it.

Water

This is the single most important need these trees have. They must **never** be allowed to dry out, either in the pot or in the ground. If you keep them moist, they will reward you with rapid growth and more spectacular trunk coloration.

Fertilizer

Once established, these trees are able to fend for themselves so long as the soil they are planted in is reasonably fertile. If the soil is poor, give them a granular fertilization at least twice per year, using 12-6-8 or a similar formulation. Make sure you do not place fertilizer right at the base of the stem or trunk. If you must

keep the tree in the pot for a while, water once per week with a mix made from a soluble formulation such as Peters or Miracle-Gro. Check the label for the rate and use half the amount recommended on the label so as to avoid burning the roots. Once per month, give them supplemental chelated iron until established.
